TEXTILES & DESIGN for the HSC

For students in years 11 & 12 studying or intending to study
Textiles & Design for the HSC.

The workshop specifically looks at the requirements and marking criteria
of the Major Textile Project Supporting Documentation guidelines
to assist students in developing high standard illustrations/production
drawings and planning a sophisticated presentation for any of the 5 focus
areas.

Outcomes of the workshop:

Students will

- learn how to successfully source creative concepts for inspiration for an MTP and understand how to evolve these into an innovative design.
- look at where to source, and creative ways to use materials and fabrics, to create unique textile designs and/or surface decoration.
- look at many examples of folios and presentation techniques and discuss graphic layout, collage, mounting, labelling, etc.
- understand how to refine design features/details in the Visual Design Development section of the Supporting Documentation,
- spend time looking at, and discussing illustration and rendering techniques, and mediums available to represent various fabrics and textures. Students will be given time to practice drawing a design and rendering with colour mediums. The lecturer will demonstrate rendering techniques including tone and imitating texture, and to understand what is required in the Manufacturing Specifications. Lecturer will demonstrate production drawing and discuss labelling and presentation.
- students currently in year 12, may ask for technical advice specific to the best presentation of their project.
